# *From the Pastor's Desk*

September 23/24, 2023

Dear Beloved of God,

Technically or officially, fall or autumn begins on September 23, but already, as I write this, the days feel like autumn has already arrived. Once again, we are reminded that with the changing of the seasons time marches onward.

Around here, of course, fall means that summer activities are put aside as the school year resumes. With the beginning of school, we have football games, tailgating, warmer clothing, the changing leaves, and a host of other activities associated with the fall season. Many people like this season, especially those who are not fond of heat, but for some of us, the coming of autumn is bittersweet as we bid farewell to the summer months and all that is associated with that season.

Each season here has its own unique attractions and benefits. The changing seasons remind us that life goes on. We are also reminded that the God who created all of this is still actively involved in creation. We humans are not very good stewards of creation and so each season also poses severe weather from time to time, but God has not abandoned us yet, and won't according to the promises God has made. As Psalm 46:1-3 reminds us:

For the past few weeks we have had a church choir once again, welcoming Graham Sanders as our conductor; the singers are having great fun! We had the entire worship space painted, refreshing the walls and ceiling of the room. Beautiful! Of course, we continue to welcome visitors to our worship nearly every week.

Children's Church has resumed with Tricia Hunt as the key leader along with some other parents. We have four students in the Deeper Waters class with Pastor Ron instructing; this class meets after the Sunday morning worship. After several years we will once again offer 1<sup>st</sup> Communion Instruction for younger disciples wishing to begin receiving holy communion. Sessions will be offered on Sundays in October, at 11 am (Deeper Waters class will not meet in October). Finally, roughly two dozen people have been attending the Wednesday night Dinner and "The Chosen", a wonderful addition to our spiritual development as disciples.

God is good and continues to bless us that we might be a blessing to others. Thank you for your partnership in this ministry as we seek to fulfill the mission to which Jesus has called, namely making disciples of Christ!
