help would be appreciated.

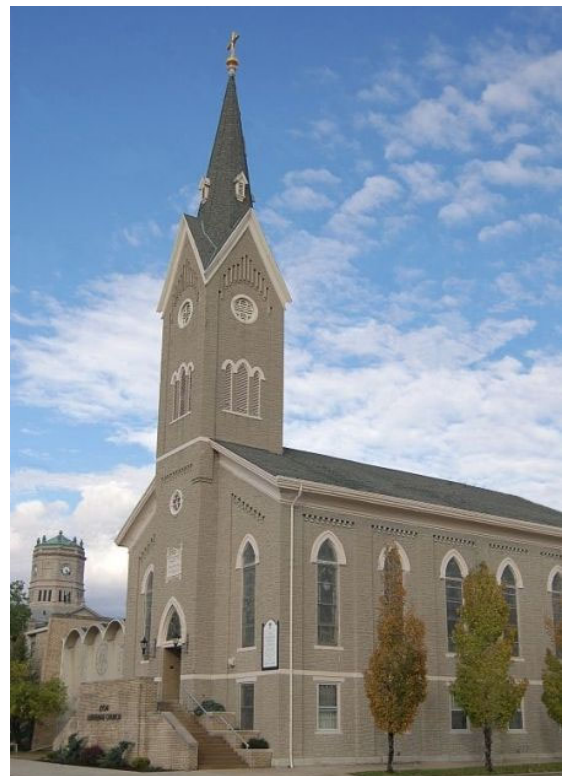
