## AROUND THE WORLD IN WORD AND SONG: CHRIST REVEALED IN MUSIC

On Wednesday, March 23, Grace Lutheran Church is offering an ecumenical program and concert that explores Jesus' life from the prophecies of Advent through Maundy Thursday in music from around the world. An international fellowship meal is open to all at 5:00 pm. Poetry readings, a presentation about Christianity around the world, prayer labyrinths, and an international cross display are at 6:00 and a concert follows at 7:00 in the Sanctuary. There is no admission fee. Donations are accepted for the dinner; a freewill offering at the concert helps to defray costs and supports Interfaith Human Services. Fourteen churches are represented and everyone is welcome!

Blanchard Church of Christ will present their annual Easter musical drama, *King of Kings*, on March 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, and 20 at 7:00 pm. A musical prelude will begin each night at 6:15. *King of Kings* is a musical drama depicting the entire life of Jesus Christ from prophecy through the second coming. The story unfolds through scriptural narration, dramatic action and vocal and instrumental music.

## INTERESTING INFORMATION ABOUT WORSHIP (from the ELCA website and Wikipedia)

A **lectionary** is a book or listing that contains a collection of [scripture](#) readings appointed for [Christian](#) or [Judaic](#) worship on a given day or occasion.

The lectionaries are organized into three-year cycles of readings. The years are designated *A*, *B*, or *C*. Each yearly cycle begins on the first Sunday of [Advent](#) (the last Sunday of November or first Sunday of December). Year B follows year A, year C follows year B, then back again to A.

Year A: [Gospel of Matthew](#) (December 2013 through 2014)

Year B: [Gospel of Mark](#) (December 2014 through 2015)

Year C: [Gospel of Luke](#) (December 2015 through 2016)

The [Gospel of John](#) is read throughout [Easter](#), and is used for other liturgical seasons including [Advent](#), [Christmas](#), and [Lent](#) where appropriate.

**Year C (2015-16) focuses on the Gospel of Luke.** The semi-continuous Old Testament readings are of prophetic proclamation chosen in chronological order and highlighting Jeremiah. The second, New Testament, readings are chosen mainly from Galatians, Colossians, 1 and 2 Timothy and 2 Thessalonians.

<b>Time after Epiphany</b> Jan. 6, 2016 through Feb. 9, 2016	<b>Lent</b> Feb. 10, 2016 through Mar. 23, 2016
<b>The Three Days</b> Mar. 24, 2016 through Mar. 26, 2016	<b>Easter</b> Mar. 27, 2016 through May 18, 2016
<b>Time after Pentecost</b> May 19, 2016 through Nov. 23, 2016
