**From Route 26 South:** At the signal light in Pleasant Gap turn right onto Route 144 North (S. Main Street)

**From State College on Route 26:** At the signal light in Pleasant Gap turn left onto Route 144 North (S. Main Street)

Follow Route 144 North past the Pleasant Hills development on the right, then make a right onto Steeplechase Drive (Steeplechase Drive is across from the Pennsylvania Fish Commission and Spring Run Mini-Golf), and follow to the top of the hill. At the stop sign, go straight into The Oaks at Pleasant Gap. Please enter through the doors at The Court apartments.
