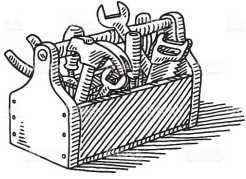

Dr. Krieger is widely regarded for his virtuosity on the organ and harpsichord, with a focus on Renaissance and Baroque music from Spain, Italy, and Germany. He received his undergraduate music education in Brazil and Germany, and completed graduate degrees in music at Brigham Young University and the University of Nebraska–Lincoln. He has performed solo recitals in North and South America, Germany, Austria, Spain, and Italy, as well as performing with other music ensembles.

The Susquehanna University Handbell Choir is one of several performing arts clubs open to all students at the University. They perform throughout the year at the University Chapel Sunday worship service, and at other special events on and off campus.
