

Their Presbytery has awarded them a Certificate of Earth Care and recently asked them to offer a workshop for the other area Presbyterian churches. Not only have they cut back on energy use in a variety of ways, but they also recycle, literally, a ton of

material each month. Please come with your own experiences retrofitting old churches

and, together, we'll brainstorm possible solutions.





Many of you know that one of our twin daughters was afflicted with M.S. a little over seven years ago. The good news is that for most of the 1.000.000 Americans with M.S., there are now over a dozen treatments that for most have substantially improved the lives of those afflicted. Our daughter, Melissa, doesn't let it slow her down very much. She gets tired and a few months ago did have to go through her third time of three days of steroid treatments to combat the numbness in her legs and hands. She is currently an assistant principal of a 2800 student High School in Orlando and is awaiting her opportunity to be a principal.

The first weekend of May will be our 7th year of riding 100 miles on our bicycles in the Florida Citrus Tour. Melissa's Stampede has raised nearly \$70,000 over these seven years and Melissa, her twin sister, myself, and a team of 13 to 18 others continue to ride the 100 miles to find a cure.


Adopt A Spot: Care for Creation & Honor Trinity

Megan Orient adopted a spot in 2014 in Ferguson Township, and had it signed "In Honor of Trinity Lutheran Church". Megan and her family are moving away this summer, and would love to see a Trinity Member keep the church name up on the sign! Are you passionate about battling litter? Would you be interested in taking it over? One person can do it—Megan has done it by herself, even separating recyclables and trash as she goes (though she said two people would be twice the fun!).

This spot is a 1/2 mile stretch of Vairo Blvd. (from just past Waddle Road to Marjorie Mae Street). It is downwind from the Walmart Plaza and two large apartment complexes, so trash seems to blow that direction. It is fairly easy to maintain! If working alone, it only requires about 4 hours each spring, 4 hours in late summer (before summer grass gets deep, and before autumn leaves fall, respectively).

In addition to the sign - a great (and free) way to recognize our church, there is a special recognition event for volunteers each year.
