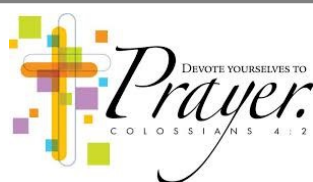

The 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Trash to Treasure Sale is scheduled for June 2 at Beaver Stadium. Each year over 60 tons of donated goods from Penn State students moving out of the residence halls is collected and sorted to be resold at a discounted price. It is the largest recycling event in the area and allows community members to get great deals on a variety of items while supporting local health and human service agencies.

The Trash to Treasure set-up and sorting process begins on May 5 and continues until sale day. We rely heavily on volunteers to help us get ready for over one thousand shoppers who attend the sale.
