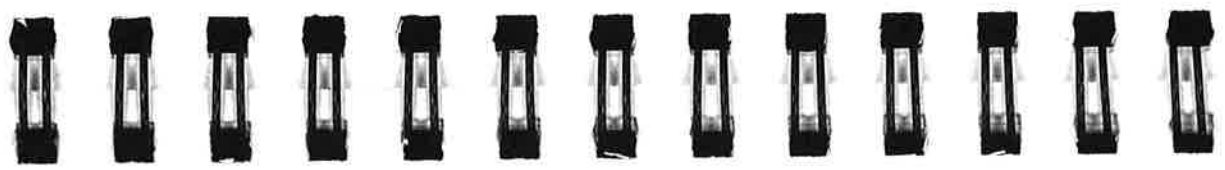
At that moment, the substitute organist played "The Star Spangled Banner". And that's how the substitute organist became the regular organist.
