

Trinity members, it's time for the traditional Holiday Food Drive that we do each year in conjunction with the Toys for Tots Drive.

Last year the area food pantries provided food for over **3696 families** throughout the year. The number of individuals needing assistance

continues to increase and there are times that giving does not keep up with the demand for food. During the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays, many times, they see a shortage of food for those in need.

Trinity, along with a number of businesses and other churches have joined the Holiday Food Drive and we have been able to help keep the food pantry shelves filled.
