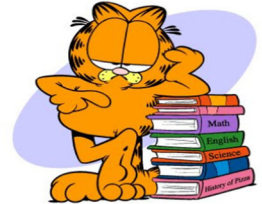

The National M.S. Society has an annual 100 mile bike ride in Florida on March 7th & 8th, 2020.

This will be the 9th year for Melissa's Stampede to be riding in this fund raiser.

In the first 8 years, her team has raised over \$90,000 and hopes to raise an additional \$10,000 this year. Gene Weller is a rider in this 100 mile trek.
