For indoor services, especially Sunday morning, since there will be singing, please wear a mask. Thank you.

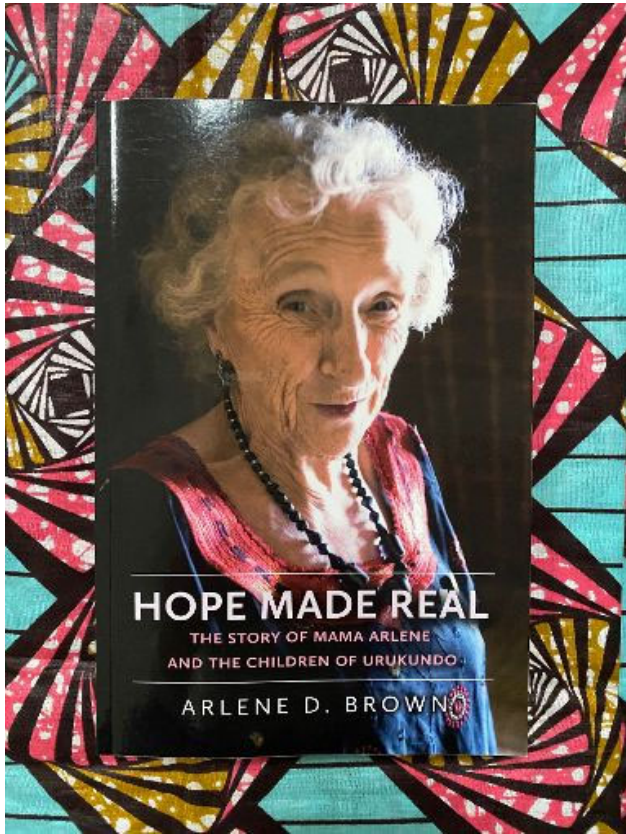


CONGREGATIONAL MEETINGS
