Shoe Drive Fundraiser



April is “Adopt-a-Greyhound Month” and the Nittany Greyhounds, a non-profit greyhound adoption organization, is celebrating with a Shoe Drive Fundraiser.

There will be a white cardboard collection bin with a Shoe Drive poster on it in the narthex. We will be doing this for the month of April. They collect pairs of shoes, boots and even flip flops.

The Nittany Greyhound organization is in partnership with Funds2Orgs (funds2orgs.com) and at the end of May they give all the shoes to Funds2Orgs and receive a donation based on the number of pairs they collect. The shoes go to disaster relief and to micro-entrepreneurs in developing areas of the world.



Nittany Greyhounds is a 501(c)(3) animal welfare organization that transports, rehabilitates, and rehomes retired racing greyhounds, both domestic and internationally. Since 1997, they have placed more than 2,000 greyhounds in homes.

They are currently expanding their fundraising efforts to support their newest program: the Injured Dogs Program (providing veterinary care for injured racers prior to adoption) and the International Greyhound Movement (partnering with this program to bring Irish racing greyhounds to America for adoption).

If you have shoes you no longer like or wear, please consider dropping them in the Nittany Greyhound’s collection box during the month of April.
