From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Beloved of God,

As I sit down to write this I found myself thinking of the phrase, "make a joyful noise unto the Lord." Musicians think of that "joyful noise" from the perspective of singing or playing an instrument. The phrase comes from Psalm 100:

Make a joyful noise to the LORD, all the earth. Serve the LORD with gladness; come into his presence with singing.

Know that the LORD is God.

It is he who made us, and we are his;
we are his people and the sheep of his pasture.

Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise.
Give thanks to him; bless his name.

For the LORD is good; his steadfast love endures forever and his faithfulness to all generations.



We may also think that the music must be excellent, but the psalmist does not say, "make joyful music to the Lord," rather "make a joyful noise to the Lord." Of course, this joyful noise is also associated with worship. In worship, we offer God our thanks and praise, "not as we ought but as we are able," a phrase from one of our prayers for worship. Still, since our worship is offered to God, we seek to offer our best, knowing that our best may from certain perspectives might not be much different than the artwork our soon-to-be-four-year-old makes. Yet, when we receive the outcome of such projects they are akin to masterpieces to us.

As you know for the past few years Barb Roberts has helped us offer our thanks and praise in worship by playing the piano.
