DEEPER WATERS CLASS

As younger disciples develop, they reach an age and ability to begin understanding more abstract concepts in life, including a comprehension of God and other aspects of our Christian Faith. Accordingly, the church has offered classes to help developing such developing disciples come to a deeper grasp and appreciation for their faith rooted in Baptism.

Traditionally this involved young people who are in Sixth, Seventh and/or Eighth Grades. We call this 3-year course of study, Deeper Waters, indicating that the students will venture into the deeper waters of our faith associated with Baptism. To that end, this fall Deeper Waters (DW) classes will begin on Sunday, September 15. The class begins right after the morning worship schedule concludes, about 11 am, and class ends by 12 pm. The class is taught by Pastor Ron.

1ST COMMUNION CLASS

Most children seek to participate in various activities as a member of the family. They tend to do the same in other settings such as church activities, particularly worship. As children reach a point where they can eat bread, they may become interested in participating more fully in Holy Communion. To that end, we here at Trinity offer a 1st Communion Class for children whose parents feel their child is old enough to receive the Sacrament. We have no set age for 1st Communion, the parents decide.

So, if you have a child or children, you feel are ready to begin receiving Holy Communion plan now to attend two Sunday morning classes, October 6 and October 13, both sessions. At least, one parent is asked to attend. Course materials are provided. A light luncheon will be served to participants.

Children who participate in the two sessions will be celebrated on Sunday, November 3, All Saints' Sunday, at either of the two morning worship services. Contact Pastor Ron to register your student or if you have questions.
