CHRISTMAS CAROLING

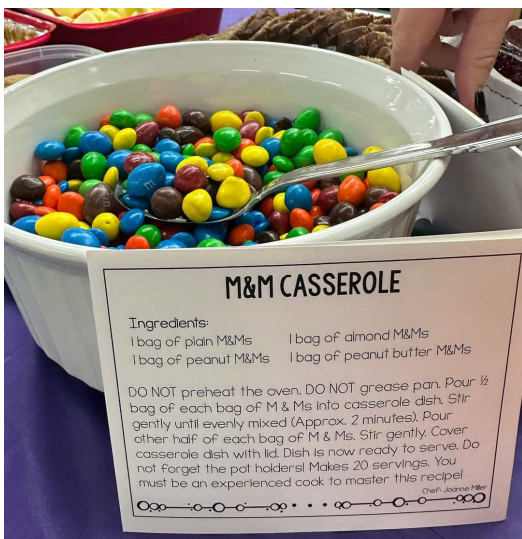
