

### Did you know ...?

**Interfaith Human Services (IHS)** was formed church leaders who recognized the need for a central organization where they could refer individuals who routinely came to them for financial assistance. IHS programs aid individuals and families to achieve financial stability. Programs include:

- The Financial Care Program assists individuals who are deemed unable to manage their money due to mental health or intellectual disabilities. Case managers handle clients' funds to ensure their basic needs are met and bills are paid on time.
- ♦ The Emergency Vehicle Repair Program helps to keep our working low-incoming neighbors on the job. Assistance through this program means that an unexpected car repair cost doesn't mean losing their job.
- The Centre County Fuel Bank Program works to help individuals and families to avoid heating emergencies. The program operates from January 1–March 31, assisting with heating oil, wood, propane, coal, and wood, to eligible residents.
- ♦ The Free Furniture and Appliance Recycling Program provides gently used household furniture, beds, and large electrical appliances at no cost to eligible individuals and families in Centre County. Offsetting the cost of furnishings and large appliances helps households stretch their income to cover other necessities.

Volunteers and staff at IHS also assist people to find other programs and services that help to meet their needs. Help is only a phone call away!
