



Bridge of Hope is a local ministry that supports single moms experiencing homelessness or housing insecurity. Bridge of Hope provides rental assistance and case management for up to 18 months. It's a long term program, which sets the families up for success!

A unique part of Bridge of Hope's model is that each of the participating families is paired with a group of neighboring volunteers from a local church. The neighboring volunteers help in practical ways - childcare, transportation, meals, etc. Many of the moms connected to Bridge of Hope are very isolated, so neighboring volunteers provide relational connections. Neighboring volunteers are welcome to talk about faith, invite the families to church, etc.

<u>Bridge of Hope has two new moms</u> coming into the ministry and we're looking for neighboring volunteers -- both of them are leaving domestic violence situations and are determined to be successful. We'd love to have people rally around them!


