# FROM PASTOR'S DESK

December 6/7, 2025

Advent 2

Dear Beloved of God,

As you know, we are into the Advent Season that leads to Christmas. As always, people are very busy this year not only attending to daily duties and responsibilities but also investing time in the special activities we all do to make the season special for ourselves and our loved ones. The same is true in the church. As we move through this season of "waiting and watching," we read the assigned passages that suggest God is also busy preparing us for Christmas.

This weekend, Advent 2, we read a familiar passage from Matthew. John the Baptizer begins his ministry of preparing for the coming of the Messiah. He proclaims good news in the wilderness that to our ears may not sound so good:

<sup>7</sup>But when he saw many Pharisees and Sadducees coming for baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the wrath to come? <sup>8</sup>Bear fruit worthy of repentance. <sup>9</sup>Do not presume to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our ancestor'; for I tell you, God is able from these stones to raise up children to Abraham. <sup>10</sup>Even now the ax is lying at the root of the trees; every tree therefore that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

<sup>11</sup>"I baptize you with water for repentance, but one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. <sup>12</sup>His winnowing fork is in his hand, and he will clear his threshing floor and will gather his wheat into the granary; but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire." (Mt. 3:7-12)

Perhaps like you, there are people, both individuals and groups, to whom I might like to address in the same vain as John. "You snakes in the grass..." (I know, I know, we are to love our enemies, and this is the season for love, but...!) Let me explain.

There are people who use their IT talents, not to benefit others but to take advantage of them. Recently you may have received an email that looked like it was from me. Unfortunately, it was NOT! It was/is a scam. I think there were at least two versions. One was that I had an important issue or matter I wanted to discuss with you and would do so the next time we met. I think that was a prelude to their real objective, so if you replied to the first you would get a second email. That email requested you to buy gift cards, scratch off the area to reveal the code number, take pictures of the numbers and email them back. Unfortunately, once someone has those numbers the now have the money that was put on the gift card. To my knowledge, there is no way to retrieve the money or to track down the "snakes"! (I hope there is a special place you know where for people who do this kind of thing to others!)

That noted, I would NEVER email or text you a request for money or gift cards. I would either call you or speak to you face to face. The only time I might discuss gift cards via email or text would be as a means of following up on something we have already agreed to doing. So, if you have doubts about any emails or text you think might be from me, please, please, call me.

I am profoundly sorry if you have been tricked by any emails that you think came from me, or from anyone else for that matter.

Yes, we are all busy preparing for Christmas and looking forward to celebrating the Birth of the Christ Child. Unfortunately, as John the Baptist reminds us, there are some who seem hellbent on ruining our plans for their own benefit! May God protect us from such scoundrels!

May you and your family have a wonderful Advent season! As we wait and watch, may God truly make us "as wise and serpents (snakes) and as innocent as doves." (Mt. 10:16)


