
BREAKING FREE THE TRANSFORMATION OF EVERYDAY LIFE

He has ministered extensively in Franciscan Spirituality as a formator in his own community in both initial and ongoing formation, through the Franciscan Federation of the U.S. and as a spiritual assistant to the Secular Franciscan Order at the local, provincial, and regional levels. He is the author of several books and articles on various aspects of the spiritual life. His most recent book, *The One Body of Christ in a Quantum Age*, published in 2024, explores the relationship between spirituality and contemporary science.
