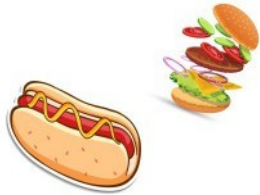

Announcement of Trinity Congregation Meeting

The Trinity Congregation is scheduled to meet on June 6 and 7, 2026. A call committee is currently being formed, and its members will be announced at the meeting.

Two amendments to the TLC bylaws have been proposed. These amendments would grant the Council President and Vice President check-signing authority in the Treasurer's absence. The congregation will discuss and vote on these proposals during the meeting.

1. Check Signing Authority

If the treasurer is unavailable, the President of the church council is authorized to sign checks on behalf of the organization.

2. Check Signing Authority

If the treasurer and Council President are unavailable, the Vice-President of the church council is authorized to sign checks on behalf of the organization.
